Deed Research via the NYC Real Property Records Office - Historic Ownership

- Use NYC Department of Buildings website to obtain block and lot number beforehand
- Search either microfilm or docket books for lot; files are organized by block number
- Both microfilm and docket books offer source info for past ownership and conveyance dates
- "Grantor" = Seller / "Grantee" = Buyer
- Docket books also offer an abbreviated history of the block at the front of each section





