Besides making cities more affordable and architecturally interesting, tall buildings are greener than sprawl, and they foster social capital and creativity.








Evolution of Structural Systems






Figure 22. Distributions of mean vertical velocity near building surface.




Figure 35: Portion of the confusing Zoning Diagram submitted for the development at 200 Amsterdam Avenue




Figure 36: Aerial image showing proposed tower at 200 Amsterdam Avenue and zoning lot in red
